# INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The primary investment objective of the portfolio is to provide the investor with a high level of income while preserving capital in real terms.

Investments to be included in the portfolio will, apart from assets in liquid form, consist of participatory interests and other forms of participation of local and global collective investment schemes. The underlying portfolios may invest in, amongst others, equity securities, property securities, non-equity securities, interest bearing securities, money market instruments, preference shares, bonds and other interest bearing instruments and securities.


