

## 4D BCI AGGRESSIVE FLEXIBLE FUND OF FUNDS (A)

### INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The investment objective of the portfolio is to maximise long term total returns at reduced risk levels compared to equity only portfolios.

### INVESTMENT POLICY

An aggressively managed flexible fund of funds portfolio aiming to maximise long term total returns at reduced risk levels compared to equity only portfolios. Consisting, apart from assets in liquid form, solely of participatory interests and other forms of participation of local and global collective investment schemes, where schemes are operated outside South Africa, inclusion is subject to a regulatory environment that provides investor protection at least equal to that in South Africa. The underlying portfolios may invest in, amongst others, equity securities, property securities, non-equity securities, money market instruments, preference shares, bonds and other interest bearing instruments and securities.

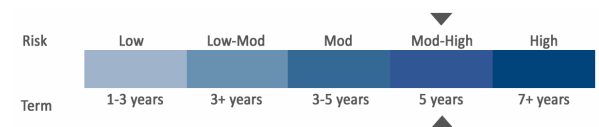

### Moderate - High Risk
